C*hildren & Schools*, a practice-oriented journal, is actively soliciting manuscripts on issues relevant to social work services in education.

Manuscripts related to early intervention programs, such as preschool and elementary education, and transitions to adulthood are welcome. The editorial board particularly encourages practitioners to share their practice knowledge and welcomes articles on innovations in practice, cultural diversity, interdisciplinary efforts, legislation, policy, planning, and administration.

The editorial board of *Children & Schools* strives to include articles that appeal to its broad constituency, addressing both practice and policy issues.

Manuscripts for full-length articles **may not exceed 20 pages**, including all references and tables.

Authors are also invited to submit manuscripts for the following columns:

- *Practice Highlights* presents descriptive case studies of authors' direct work with individuals and families. Manuscripts with a strong emphasis on interdisciplinary collaboration are encouraged. Practice Highlights submissions **should not exceed six pages**.
- *As Readers See It* provides a forum for letters and comments from readers. The editorial board welcomes opinions of interest to the field and comments on articles published in the journal. These comments or letters **should not exceed two pages**.
